I Will

For all Adult Volunteers

- **Complete the BMBC Ministry With Minors Form.**
- **Be at least 21 years old or have completed my sophomore year in college.**
- **Model Christ like behavior.** Be committed to a lifestyle and choices that are both Godly and above reproach, knowing that my lifestyle is a model for the students.
- **Obey all rules.**
- **Be a greeter.** Help students feel welcomed and valued.
- **Respond to noise and disruption.** Encourage students to pay attention and to respect the attention of others.
- **Report any suspected abuse.** We are required by law to report suspected physical, sexual and emotional abuse.

For Sunday School Teachers and Deeper Group Leaders

- **Arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of an event.** Early arrival demonstrates care.
- **Be prepared.** It's not just for boy scouts. Know your material.
- **Make contact when a student is absent for three weeks.**
- **Encourage student interaction.** Introduce new students to other students and facilitate interaction.
- **Be committed to growing and maturing in my relationship with Christ.**
- **Commit to at least 1 year.** Relationships require time, don't give up!
- **Attend my program consistently.**
- **Give Jimmy or the Sunday School Director at least one week's notice if I can not attend my program.**
- **Give feedback to Jimmy.** Please let me know if you have a problem, a success, or an idea.

I Will Not

- **Be alone with a student of the opposite sex.** For any reason or for any length of time. This is for your protection as well as the student's.
- **Encourage disruption.**
- **Promise to keep a secret.** If a student asks you to keep a secret say "depends what it is." If a student confides something that can either harm them or someone else tell Jimmy immediately.
- **Have an inappropriate relationship with a student or volunteer.**
- **Gossip about or disrespect parents, other volunteers, or church leadership in front of students.** Model the way a Christian should resolve differences by going directly to the individual. Remember, if they see you do it, they think they can do it.
